But as she became a mother, she struggled with addiction, and I was called to be a mother again to support her children. To ensure that Antoine, our youngest grandson, could stay with his family and avoid placement in foster care, my husband Wayman and I chose to adopt him.

As older parents, we wanted to ensure that Antoine would have the opportunity to interact with children his own age and grow intellectually and emotionally, something that was not possible in our West Philadelphia neighborhood. Antoine came to us unsure of what his future held, and asked for a chance to have a different kind of school experience. He had seen his older siblings benefit from unique opportunities in their lives, and wanted the same chance to find his purpose.

Choosing Girard College was easy for our family. I Knew from our first visit that Girard would be a safe place for Antoine to live and learn. He would be protected from the violence of city streets and benefit from a nurturing community around him.

Since enrolling in 5th grade, Antoine has thrived. He's grown into an expressive and caring young man and has enjoyed learning, making friends, helping others, and playing sports. I know he will take the values gained at Girard back to his community as he grows into adulthood.
